Having reviewed Paul's email below and noting the very minor nature of the works, I recommend that the following reasoned determination can be made:

*Having performed screening for Appropriate Assessment in respect of the proposed reactive maintenance works detailed in the email received from Paul O'Donoghue PhD dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2020, and entitled 'Re. Reactive Maintenance works at DL-N56-022.00 Commons Bridge, Co. Donegal', I accept the recommendations of Atkins Limited that the proposed reactive maintenance works, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, would not be likely to have a significant effect on any European site in view of the best scientific knowledge and the site's conservation objectives.
